

To Swim Team Parents:

As you may know, the USC Swim Club has been managing the swimming lesson program for the community the past few years. This effort is very important in teaching the younger children of our community the basic swimming skills which builds their confidence and allows them to enjoy the water. In return, the Swim Club generates a small profit which helps cover our annual operating budget. The lessons are usually given by Club swimmers that are either in high school or junior high and oversight is provided by our coaching staff.

Given that we are in the middle of the high school swim season and at the height of club swimming, we are having difficulty finding swimmers that can teach our next six weeks of lessons. These lessons are held at the High School pool and are scheduled for Sundays from 12:00 pm - 1:30 pm beginning this Sunday, January 27 and concluding on March 2.

Though a fundamental understanding of swimming and a willingness to get into the pool are prerequisites, you do not have to be an accomplished swimmer with a competitive background to volunteer. We are looking for those who are energetic and bring an enthusiastic approach to this effort. Our coaching staff will provide some quick training tips and helpful hints that would be useful during the short lesson time.

We recognize that everyone has a busy calendar but if you could give us a little of your time, we know that this would be a fulfilling venture. Also note, we are not asking you to commit for the entire six Sundays as any day(s) would be more than helpful.
